Mini *Atlas*.

3 prompts from the operator stack. The free sample of the Prompt Atlas. Paste them once. See if they earn their place.

3 prompts. *One per work mode.*

The Prompt Atlas ships 28 paste-ready prompts across five operator categories. This Mini-Atlas is the free sample. One prompt from Triage. One from Draft. One from Review. The shape, the voice, the cadence, the same. Paste them this week. If the 3 earn their place, the \$17 Tripwire ships 7 (one per category) and the \$79 Atlas ships all 28 plus an MCP bootstrap and a saved-context template.

THE 3 PROMPTS

PROMPT 01	<i>Meeting prep</i>	Tomorrow's calendar into agendas, questions, risks. From the Triage category.
PROMPT 02	<i>Email reply</i>	A short, voice-matched draft from one inbound. From the Draft category.
PROMPT 03	<i>Pre-publish gate</i>	Kill, fix, or ship verdict on any draft. From the Review category.

Paste-ready. *Edit one line.*

1 OUTCOME: TOMORROW'S CALENDAR PREPPED IN 5 MINUTES The meeting-prep prompt

Paste into any LLM

Below is tomorrow's calendar. For each meeting, output:

1. Agenda in 3 bullets
2. 3 questions I should ask
3. 1 risk I should surface

Skip meetings that are 1:1 routine. Flag any meeting where I do not know the owner.

2 OUTCOME: A 2 TO 4 SENTENCE REPLY IN YOUR VOICE, READY TO SEND The email-reply prompt

Paste into any LLM

Below is one inbound email I owe a reply on. Draft a 2 to 4 sentence response. Direct. No filler. Match my voice from the saved-context (first name only, no em-dashes, plain English).

- Output:
1. Subject line
 2. Body
 3. One alternative body if I want to push back gently

Inbound:

Context for the reply:
[paste 1 to 3 sentences of background]

3 OUTCOME: KILL, FIX, OR SHIP VERDICT BEFORE YOU PUBLISH

The pre-publish gate prompt

Paste into any LLM

Below is a draft I am about to publish. Score it on:

1. Promise made in line 1 (Y / N)
2. Promise paid by line 5 (Y / N)
3. One specific claim with a number or a name (Y / N)
4. Any banned token: em-dash, throat-clear ("In today's world"), passive opener (Y / N)
5. The single line I should delete if I had to cut one

Verdict at the bottom: KILL (start over), FIX (rewrite the 3 issues), or SHIP.

Draft:

3 prompts that earn their place beats 28 in a saved file.

The other 25. *And the system.*

The 3 prompts above are one per category for the first three of five categories. The Tripwire fills in Decide and Deliver. The Atlas fills the gaps and adds the saved-context template that makes every prompt twice as useful.

What the *\$17 Tripwire* adds

7 prompts hand-picked from the Atlas. One per category, no overlap with the 3 above. Plus the free saved-context template that anchors the 7. The Tripwire is the bridge between this free sample and the full \$79 Atlas. If 3 was enough, save your \$17.

What the *\$79 Atlas* adds

All 28 prompts across 5 categories: Triage, Draft, Decide, Review, Deliver. A saved-context system prompt that primes every chat. A Custom Instructions block. A 5-server MCP bootstrap for tool-use. The full operator stack as a single PDF you paste once and run forever.
